Astoria City Council Goals

- **Explore options to enhance long-term financial sustainability of the Parks Department, including but not limited to, a cemetery facilities masterplan.**
- **Pursue a public-private partnership for the redevelopment of Heritage Square to include housing.**
- **Increase disaster resilience among the community, City staff, and facilities.**

- **Explore options for revenue generation, expense reduction, and streamlining internal processes to allow staff to focus on priorities.**
- **Maintain Astoria's unique character in Council decisions, including those involving zoning, growth and economic development.**
- **Vigorously support renovation of the Astor Library and the Foundation's fundraising for it.**
- **Work with community partners to implement the five year economic development strategy.**
