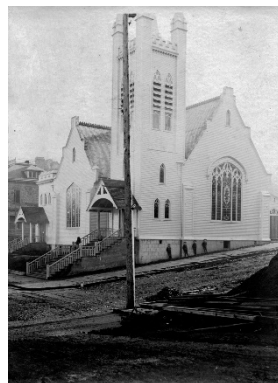


31 Activities you can do in the CITY OF ASTORIA...

- 2. Visit the Clatsop County Historical Museum exhibit: "Away From Home"
- 3. Listen to "Preservation Playlist" on Spotify
- 4. Shop in the Astoria Downtown Historic District
- 5. Visit Columbia River Maritime Museum's exhibit: "Twin Palaces of the Pacific"
- 6. Find the 1922 Fire marker / monument
- 7. Ride a bike across the historic Old Youngs Bay Bridge and the Lewis & Clark Bridge
- 8. Visit the "Triangle Tavern" and "Workers Tavern" in Uniontown
- 9. Stay in a historic accommodation
- 10. Admire local winners of the "DeMuro Award for Excellence in Preservation": M&N Building and the Astoria Train Station (<https://restoreoregon.org/demuro-awards/>)
- 11. Tour the historic area at Fort Stevens or Fort Columbia
- 12. See where Astor's trading post once stood; Walk the green line between Duane and Exchange Streets
- 13. Discover your home's history (LCPS – <https://www.lcpsociety.org/research.html>)
