A Subcommittee, of the Budget Committee, for the City of Astoria reviewed grant applications on March 10, 2022 to put forward a recommendation to the City of Astoria Budget Committee for consideration. Please note at this stage these are recommendations and are not approved or final.

Budget Committee meetings begin April 25, 2022.

After budget review and approval, the budget (which includes grant awards) will be presented to City Council, on June 6, 2022, for adoption. Grant award information will be presented to council by the July 18, 2022 meeting and distributions will be made to organizations by July 31, 2022.
